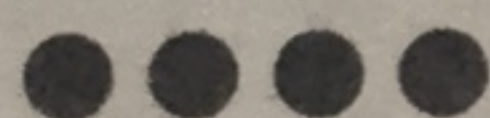
# Portraits exhibition se

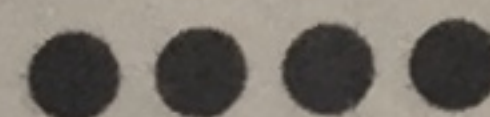
The exhibition will be held in the Metropolitan Life Gallery, Church Street, and will be opened on Monday evening by Louis Jansen van Vuuren.

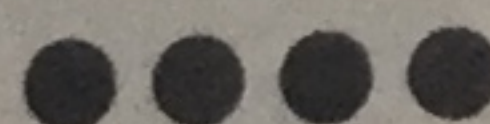
Muller's subjects are mainly landscapes.
