

Van Vuuren takes over

MR Louis Jansen van Vuuren, 37, who has been a member of the committee of the SA Association of Arts (Western Cape) for many years, has been elected chairman following the resignation of Mr Melvyn Minnaar, who will remain on the committee.

The rest of the committee remains unchanged, with Susan Loppert as vice-chairman.

Mr Jansen van Vuuren holds a creative-arts degree as well as an honours degree in history of art from the University of Stellenbosch. After graduating he

taught for two years at the Durban Technikon returned to Stellenbosch for eight years to teach at the University's creative-arts department and has for the past two years been a lecturer at the Michaelis School of Fine Art at UCT.

He has held numerous one-man and group shows throughout South Africa and his work is included in most major South African collections as well as the Gallery of Modern Art in San Francisco.
