Charity auction

Mother Teresa's visit to Cape Town last November provided former Zimbabwean and now Cape Town artist Trish Jaffa with the idea of holding an auction of artworks to raise funds for the Sisterhood in Khayelitsha and the Haven Night Shelter. She roped in SA Association of Arts' Louis Jansen van Vuuren to help and on Monday night such an auction, comprising 80 lots of about 60 artists (including a work by Gregoire Boonzaaier which went for a piffling R5 000) and couturiers fell under Julius Buchinsky's hammer in the Liesching Room at the President. After costs, the organisers will be able to hand over R26 000 to these charities.
