Blockbuster exhibition at AVA to end the year

TAMBOERSKLOOF resident and well-known artist Louis Jansen van Vuuren will be exhibiting works along with Willie Bester and Zwelethu Mthethwa from today, Thursday December 10 until Saturday January 16, at the Association for Visual Arts in Church Street.
