
OPENING EXHIBITION AT THE LIPSCHITZ GALLERY 138/140 BUITENGRAGT, CAPE TOWN 10 MARCH 1998

63 current works by Louis Jansen van Vuuren will be on view at the new Lipschitz Gallery, 138/140 Buitengragt, Cape Town, from 10 March 1998. The exhibition is a forerunner to his first Paris exhibition, and includes a number of works which will be exhibited in Paris during April. This will be Louis' first solo exhibition in Cape Town since 1993 and Sue Lipschitz, the owner of the Gallery, is delighted that Louis has chosen to hold his exhibition in this historic heritage building at the gateway to the Bo-Kaap.

Louis' work is loosely centred around thematic references, one of which explores the dynamics of interior/exterior space. Another series explores the tensions and energies existent between the human body/bodies within a given interior space. A third series breaks away from the convention of illusionistic composition and dislocates objects, details of figures and typography and recreates a new format for them.

Louis has exhibited with Sue Lipschitz on several international exhibitions and has expressed his delight in being represented locally in her own gallery. In his words: "the new gallery space is awesome and the nicest place in Cape Town.
